What are the requirements?

1. Meet the minimum age requirement of 19.
2. Be a citizen of the United States.
3. Be a high school graduate or possess a G.E.D. certificate that meets state standards.
4. Must possess a valid **law enforcement or corrections certificate of training**.
5. Possess a valid driver's license and a good driving record.
6. Be in good physical condition to perform job-related tasks.
7. Be of good moral character; no felony convictions; no misdemeanor convictions involving moral character, perjury, or false statements as outlined in the Florida Statutes.
8. Never have received a dishonorable discharge from any of the armed forces of the United States. (Must have Honorable Discharge)
9. Be able to successfully pass a drug screen test, physical and polygraph.



What kind of training is required?

Florida Basic Recruit Training Programs

For a career in law enforcement, there are *State of Florida* Criminal Justice Training Centers that use standards set by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.

Through its Basic Law Enforcement Program, you will learn everything from legal issues and effective communication to firearms and investigation procedures. This program prepares recruits to take the State Officer Certification Exam to be a police officer anywhere in the state and takes five and a half months to complete.
