Thank you for your interest in participating in the Nassau County Sheriff's Office Teen Driver Challenge (TDC) course. The NCSO will be offering the TDC four times a year with a class limit size of 12 participants. The TDC course, which is offered at no cost to students, will provide the knowledge and hands-on experience to reduce your chances of being involved in a crash. Please note: the Teen Driver Challenge is not a supplemental or advanced driving course. It is a defensive driving program that covers various topics including:

- Vehicle dynamics
- Human factors
- * Responsibility and liability
- Effects of drugs and alcohol
- Night driving
- **❖** Aggressive driving

To be eligible for participation you must meet the following requirements:

- ❖ 15-19 years of age and must be a licensed driver
- ❖ Learner's permit, must be accompanied to the range by an Operator-licensed driver
- ❖ Have a vehicle that you normally drive available for the range portion
- ❖ Must have 6 months of driving experience
- Proof of insurance
- ❖ Instructors will inspect all student vehicles with the students present. Any unsafe vehicles (bad tires, etc.) will not be allowed on the course

Prior to confirmation in the TDC all of the following forms will need to be completed:

- ❖ Student statement of voluntary participation and release of all claims
- ❖ Vehicle owner's statement of permission and release of all claims
- ❖ Parental permission form and release of all claims
- ❖ General release and waiver of liability
- Student Signup Information

The TDC will be held at Yulee Middle School, located at 85439 Miner Road. The TDC will be held as follows:

- February 23, 2019 from 8am to 6pm
- ❖ May 11, 2019 from 8am to 6pm
- ❖ June 22, 2019 from 8am to 6pm
- ❖ October 12, 2019 from 8am to 6pm
